Loss Of £9 Per Annum On Every Cottage

Scholarships Scheme May Be Scrapped If—

Mr D Heskin, Chairman presided at a special meeting of the Waterford County Council held in Dungarvan on Saturday last.

Discussion On Cottages
Mr J G Dowling Secretary, read a report from Mr M Flynn, Secretary County Health Section which dealt with details of an item of £1534 over-expenditure under the Labourers' Acts.

It was pointed out that expenditure had reached £24,933 while receipts were £20,074 plus £2345 provided as supplementary so that there was still a sum of £1534 in excess of receipts.

Mr Dowling said that the passing of a resolution authorising the expenditure of this amount did not involve the raising of an additional rate.

Mr O Ryan—Will it affect next year's rate?
Secretary—Yes it will.

Mr R Barron said that this money was for the cottage scheme and he thought that there should be more supervision over the way repairs were done. He said that men were on the job who were not competent and they came anytime they liked and left at anytime.

Mr M F Walsh, agreeing with Mr Barron said that there were only handymen doing repairs.

The County Manager said that it was hard to get skilled men for the work.
