TEA AND SUGAR RATIONING

Preliminary Notice to Householders, Heads of Institutions and Shopkeepers

The Minister for Industry and Commerce announces as follows
 (a) **NEW TEA REGISTRATION PAGE** It has been decided to alter the arrangements for the provision of tea supplies to traders. As from a date in the near future which will be announced shortly the supplies of tea to traders will be regulated by coupons taken from the tea registration pages of their customers. In order that this change may be made it is necessary that all householders should deposit Pages 6 (marked Tea/Tea) from the Ration Books of members of their household with the shopkeeper from whom they wish to obtain their rations of tea. Householders are warned that unless they do this not later than the 11th June they will run the risk of being unable to obtain their rations without interruption when the new arrangements take effect.
 Heads of institutions such as schools colleges convents hospitals nursing homes sanatoria etc are likewise warned that the fresh registration pages for tea in respect of all resident personnel should be lodged with their retail suppliers not later than the 11th June. All existing tea quotas and permits for institutions will be abolished on the introduction of the new arrangements.
 (b) **NEW LICENCES** The Minister is prepared to consider applications for licences from traders who are not already licensed to retail tea (and sugar). Applications for licences should be made to the Department of Industry and Commerce, Griffith Barracks Dublin and further information will then be given to applicants as to the procedure they should follow.

Abdominal Exercise—No 7
 This exercise is known as the Jack-knife. Swimmers and divers should know how to perform it. Lie in the prone position. Now try and raise your head and heels at the same time until your body and trunk are at right angles to the floor and the whole body balanced on the buttocks. Endeavour to touch your toes while in this position. Return your body to the floor take a few deep breaths and repeat. At first it will be difficult and you will have to perform it rapidly.
 No 3—This exercise is something similar to No 7 wriggle your body into position against a wall so that both legs are straight up with the wall and your body as close as can be. Now raise your trunk and try and touch your toes with your hands.
 Both of these exercises are first-class abdominal exercise but are not fit for the corpulent person who should begin with the leg raising exercises given in previous notes.

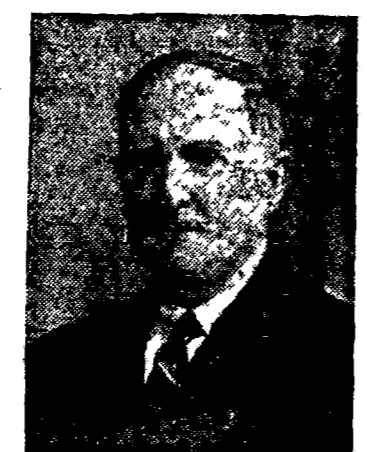
