



WARNING

Flour & Bread Rationing

It has come to the notice of the Minister for Industry and Commerce that the rationing regulations relating to flour and bread are not being fully observed. These regulations entitle every person to a weekly allowance of flour and bread. To obtain that allowance certain simple conditions have to be complied with viz. —

 (1) The householder is required to lodge with the grocer or baker pages 18 and 19 of the current book
 (2) The retailer of flour or bread is required to apply on a special form to the baker or wholesaler as the case may be for as much flour and bread as will supply the rations of the persons who have lodged ration pages with him
These simple obligations are sometimes neglected and

the Minister for Industry and Commerce feels it necessary to warn all concerned that rations of flour and bread cannot be supplied to householders or traders who fail to comply fully and promptly with the regulations






