Justice Tells Litigants To Have A Little More Practical Christianity

Assault And Trespass Cases

Dungarvan District Court was held before Mr E O'Riain D.J. on Wednesday last.

Motoring Offences

Thomas Fitzgerald Ballinacorney was fined 10/- when charged by Supt P O'Mahony for failing to give way to traffic when emerging from a bye road on to a main road. The Supt said that there had been a small collision as a result but the matter was not serious.

Trespass and Assault Claim

Angela Kiely Old Cappagh House claimed £5 damages for assault and trespass against John McGrath same address. Mr Farrell solr for plaintiff and Mr Williams solr for defendant.

Mr Farrell said that the action was in respect of an assault on his client on Oct 27th last when defendant violently pushed and squeezed and gripped her arm and tore her apron and in respect of trespass in July and October last.

Mis Kiely in evidence said that defendant was tenant of portion of her house and on Oct 27th last she saw a lorry on her front lawn at about 7 pm.
