One often hears complaints nowadays that very little Irish is spoken outside the schools. That is unfortunately true. But it may surprise you not a little if I tell you that with very few exceptions precious little Irish is spoken within the schools.

Unless the teachers make Irish the language of the school unless they address their pupils, day in day out in the language, Irish will have very little chance of survival.

Archedeaon Power having commented on the very sensible address given by An Fear Mor, agreed that the use of Irish should be encouraged more in the schools while adults and parents he said should do all they could to encourage it.
