This beautiful Irish chalice decorated with exquisite examples of Celtic work is composed of over 350 separate pieces of gold silver and bronze set with enamels and amber, it is believed to have been made in the middle of the 8th century. It was discovered at Reerasta, near Ardagh Co Limerick in 1868 and is now one of the treasures of Ireland housed in the National Museum, Dublin
