The crucial time, I understand, is caused by the recent increases in water charges. My information is that the ratepayers in the Ballyduff-Dungarvan area have taken legal advice for the purpose of obtaining Counsel's opinion as to their position with regard to these new water charges. Their case under the scheme supplying their area is more or less a private one for which the ratepayers in the area acted as guarantors when the scheme was laid something around 50 years ago and that it has long since been abandoned.

Mr M. Morrissey, Chairman of the Waterford County Council, presided at the quarterly meeting of the Council held in Dungarvan on Monday last. Present were Messrs T. A. Kyne, T. J. Fahey, J. Power, H. Dowd, K. O'Ryan, C. Curran, T. Lamen, W. Dower, N. Walsh, J. Quirk, W. Kennedy, T. D. Lynch, W. Foran, P. Butler, and Flynn.

Cost Of Health Services

Reporting on the deputation which visited the Minister for Health in Dublin on Thursday last week as to the apportionment of the charges for the extension of the Health Services to the middle income group as between the County and Waterford Corporation, the Secretary stated that while the Minister had promised that he would consider all the points put up by the deputation to have the charges apportioned on a population basis he could not give much hope that the old system of basing the charges on a valuation basis would be changed.

Proposed Extension Of Waterford Borough Boundary

A proposal from the Waterford Corporation to extend the Borough boundary by the transfer of certain areas from the county was on the proposal of Senator Butler put to the next meeting in order to obtain the views of the County Manager and Legal Adviser on the matter.
