At the monthly meeting of the Waterford Board of Assistance held in Dungarvan on Monday last a letter was read from Mr H Gill Tramore Chairman of the Board for the past two years resigning from his position.

Mr Gill's letter stated that he had resigned from the Waterford Corporation and his resignation from the Board therefore became automatic. He thanked the Co Manager and officials and members for their co-operation and help while he acted on the Board.

A reply from the Co Manager sent to Mr Gill's letter stated that they all regretted that he was severing his connection with the Board on which he had served as Chairman for the past two years.

Mr T Gallagher Mayor of Waterford who presided, said that Mr Gill had always shown the greatest interest in the work of the Board and had investigated every complaint received. His resignation would be a big loss to the Board.

The resignation was accepted with regret.

On the proposal of Mr T. Kyne, TD seconded by Mr P. Butler the Board unanimously agreed to grant an increase of £2 10s 0d a year in the remuneration of Mrs Mansfield Caretaker at Aidmore Dispensary.

The Secretary Mr J. A. Fynes stated that the caring it was an extra day's work each week for which she had applied for an additional 2 6.

ENGINEERING SERVICE CHARGES

Following a letter from Mr F. O'Leary County Accountant the Board agreed to increase their contribution to the County Council in respect of Engineering Services from £1 000 to £1 500 a year.

Mr O'Leary pointed out that the figure of £1 000 had been fixed by the County Manager in 1950 but since then there had been a number of salary and cost increases and the figure now estimated by the County Engineer to cover the services of a part-time Engineer clerk office and travelling expenses was £1 500.

£7 A Week Increase For County Physician

There's not a shillim, left in the country to employ working men because it's all going to these men, said Mr T Lannon at the monthly meeting of the Waterford Board of Assistance in Dungarvan on Monday last when he proposed an application on behalf of Dr M Shipsey County Physician Waterford for an increase of £350 a year in his remuneration.

The Secretary Mr J. A. Fynes said that the application came from the Irish Medical Association following an agreement between them and the County Managers Association and the County Physician's present inclusive salary for attendance at the County Hospital and Fever Hospital was £543 10s 8d, he added.

I think the country is going nuts altogether, remarked Mr Lannon and it's a wonder that the County Managers wouldn't take something off their own salaries to pay this. All the money is going to these men who are well off as they are and who would have private practices as well.

Mr D Fitzpatrick said that before the Health Act came into force one doctor did all the work for a salary of £500. Now they had a fleet of doctors and physicians all getting big salaries but he thought it was only fair that the salary of this physician should be brought in line with the others.

The Secretary said that the standard had increased very much and there were now many more units attached to the County Hospital which were not there five years ago.

The scale applied for he told Ald W Kenneally TD was already being paid in other counties.

Mr Lannon—Well I'm opposing it anyway and I propose that this increase be not granted.

Mr P Butler seconded said that he would not mind a small increase, but £350 a year extra was a big jump.

The Secretary said that the application arose from extended services under the Health Act.

Ald Kenneally said that while he agreed that the increase represented a big jump he thought that if a man had increased work to do he should be paid for it.

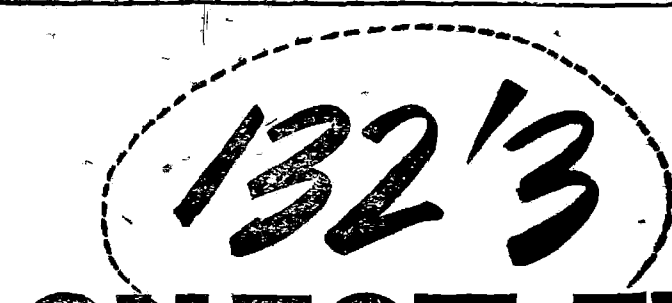
