BEHIND THE SPOTLIGHT

With **PENSMAN**

ODIOUS PRACTISES
During the course of a discussion on the Housing Priority List at the last meeting of the Dungarvan Urban Council some points for Council houses came in for a certain amount of criticism which was fully warranted. It is an effort to put the Council on the spot some applicants moved into condemned houses to get to keep dogs in from which tenants had already been evicted. The man who puts his wife and family into such a house shows scant consideration for them and he cannot blame it on the Council in turn. Such a move to force the Council into giving him a house and to place him higher on the list than people who have been waiting for years should not be countenanced. Added to this we had the reprehensible practice mentioned of one tenant selling the key of a condemned house to another. It was stated that as much as £20 had been paid for a key in one case. The Health Inspector, Mr. P. Walsh, put forward a good suggestion to counteract these moves. Any tenant found selling a key should be charged the full economic rent of the house he gets. This would probably act as a deterrent. It is certain that people seeking Council houses and who stand so low in their efforts to qualify should get short shrift.

DOCTOR'S FEES
A big bone of contention at the moment is the fees being charged for medical attention. In a short few years the charges have trebled and in some cases quadrupled to the great worry of a big section of the general public. For those in the lower income group who hold medical cards do not exist as they are covered by the terms of the Health Act. However, this section is not fully satisfied either, and it has been heard of cases where a lack of attention and interest. Medical card-holders, or at least some of them, are not always treated as they do not welcome them as they do other patients. Most worried group is the middle income and small farmer section. These fall to qualify for the benefits of the Health Act.

DUNGARVAN U.D.C. APPROVES NEW HOUSING SCHEME

Having considered in committee the Housing Priority List for the coming year at their meeting last Friday night, Dungarvan Urban Council heard a further report from the Medical Officer, Dr. M. O'Farrell, on the recent survey carried out to assess the town's housing requirements. In reply to an advertisement the report stated that 66 applications had been received for the following categories of houses: (1) 2 bedroom houses 36 applicants; (2) 3 do. 15; (3) 3 do. 36; (4) 4 do. 3. Of these the doctor recommended the following: (1) 29 recommended in category 3; (2) 9; (3) 28; (4) 3, a total of 39. The report added that of the 35 were already tenants of 2 bedroom houses and these could help to meet the demand in category 2. There was an annual turnover of 12 houses and to avoid overcrowding the report recommended that a total of 21 new houses would meet the requirements. Dr. O'Farrell said that 66 applications had been received and their present housing conditions included in the Priority List and 39 had been recommended for Council houses. The Council, he said, should not build houses for people who did not want them.

RACING DRIVER FATALLY INJURED AT DUNGARVAN Was Competing At Hill Climb Event

Tragedy struck at the Annual Speed Hill Climb Competition held by the Tipperary Light Car Club on the Sween on the main Dungarvan-Cork road outside Dungarvan on Sunday. As a result one of the drivers taking part in the event died at the local District Hospital from injuries sustained when he was involved in a crash at one of the bends. He was William Teiford, 40-year-old garage owner of Mount-rath, Co. Louth, one of the best known motor racing drivers in the country. He was no stranger to the hillside course over which his car was competing on it for a number of years past. Having had two car spins that morning, he was making his first official run over the mile and a bit hill climb when tragedy occurred. He had negotiated the first hairpin and was along the 200 yard stretch by the wide road bend at the junction when his car shot across the road and struck the low fence on the left side. It bounced over and somersaulted back on to the road twice, throwing him clear before it crashed into the undergrowth.

The large number of spectators grouped around the bend were horrified at the occurrence, and a number of them immediately went to the injured driver's assistance. Officials of the promoting Club and Rev. Cross, Dungarvan, took over and removed the injured man to the local hospital where he was moderately attended to. It was found to have sustained a fractured wrist, head injuries and severe crushing of the chest. He was also attended by Rev. Mr. W. J. McKenna, Church of Ireland, Dungarvan, who administered a very poignant feature of the tragedy was that the deceased wife Mrs. Phyllis Teiford, was present at the event. He is also survived by four children.

Following a post mortem examination at the hospital on Monday, the fatal accident occurred, but fortunately sustained no serious injuries. The competitor in the event was Mr. Liam O'Donnell, who drove his D.K.W. Saloon.

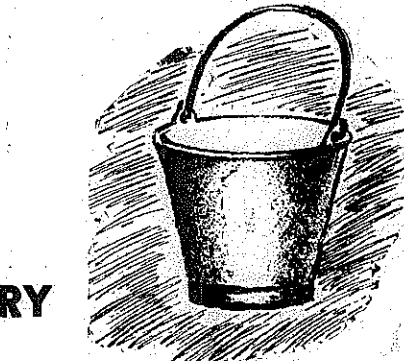
