NEW ARRANGEMENTS IN CONNECTION WITH THE BOVINE TUBERCULOSIS ERADICATION SCHEME WILL OPERATE IN THESE SIX COUNTIES FOR A PERIOD OF THREE YEARS FROM 1st OCTOBER, 1959.

- Each herd-owner in the scheme in the six counties ment uned will be free to self his cow reactors to any licensed contains from and he will receive in addition to the price paid by the cannery a headage grant of £15 from the Department.
- The animal may be sent direct to the cannery or sold to the canner's agent at a fair or mart or at the herd-owner's premises.
- (3) If the herd gets a clear test within three years from 1st October, 1959, the Department will also pay a bonus at the rate of \sim
 - (a) £8 for each cow reactor un which headage grant was paid
 - (b) £4 for each cow in the herd at the date of the clear test. (at the berd-owner's choice)
- (4) From the 1st October, the Department's present arrangements for purchasing reactors (other than reactors in pedigree herds) will cease in these six counties.
