Great interest has been aroused by a mental report Dr. Vincent G. Croft, Resident Medical Superintendent, which was placed before the members of the Waterford Mental Hospital Committee at their monthly meeting in Waterford last week. The report deals with the mental illness of only in whispers; let us rather look on it as just another type of illness which can be treated and cured and let people who require treatment be not afraid or lack the courage to attend the psychiatric clinics which have been set up in Dungarvan and Lisimore as a result of a new approach to the treatment of mental cases and Dr. Croft's report is the only way to tackle what he describes as this major medical and social problem.
