Decree For Doctor In Land Reclamation Claim
Cow Got Trapped In a Gullet

Dr. L. N. Gleeson, Stradbally, was plaintiff in an action for alleged breach of contract and negligence against Nicolaas Collier, Land Reclamation Contractor, Bridge Street, Abbeville, at Dungarvan Circuit Court on Tuesday. Plaintiff claimed £138 8s. 2d. for the loss of two cattle, one on the 27th January 1959, and the other on the 11th March 1959, due to the alleged failure of the contractor to construct a gullet in making a drain.

Dr. Gleeson in evidence said that he was a farmer at Stradbally and that he had a contract with the Minister for Land Reclamation work carried out at Dungarvan in 1958. The work was done on his farm in 1958 and 1954 by Mr. Collier who was the provision of a gullet in a roadway which ran through the farm and other works. A few months after the work was done he had to notify the Department officials in a report that the gullet had collapsed and they came and re-positioned it. It collapsed again and he entered into correspondence with the Department which lasted up to this year.

In January of this year he came to the spot where he saw one of his cows trapped in a hole between two long stones which had been placed during the positioning of the gullet. He saw the animal but was unable to get it out. The value of the cow which was only a few weeks old, was £35. There had been no salvage value from the meat.

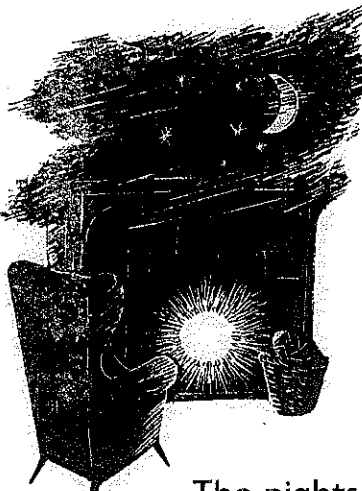
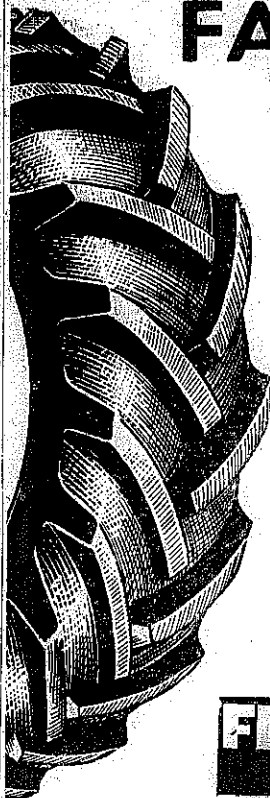
