The vaccination is available on a PAYMENT BASIS to dependants of persons:
(a) who are insured under the Social Welfare Act 1952,
(b) whose yearly income is less than £800,
(c) whose income is derived wholly or mainly from farming and the rateable valuation of the farm or farms (including buildings) is £50 or less,
(d) who would be unable, without undue hardship, to provide the service.
Application forms may be had at local dispensaries. Completed forms, and where necessary, appropriate payment, should be sent to the County Secretary, Courthouse, Dungarvan, before 5 p.m. on Thursday, March 24th.
Parents and guardians are urged to apply NOW for vaccination for their dependants, as no further scheme is contemplated this year.
