HAVE LISMORE LOST THE FIGHT? Official announcements over the week-end have indicated that the chipboard factory is to go to Tycor just outside Waterford city. For almost a year a struggle has gone on to obtain the industry for Lismore and representations at all levels have been made to this end. At one stage it looked a certainty that the Cattedrauld town was going to be the factory which would bring new life to the locality by providing much-needed, well-paid employment. But there were behind the scenes negotiations going on and a few months ago the first inkling that it was thought Lismore would be a more appropriate location for the factory. Now it would appear that Lismore has lost the fight and that the industry will be sited in Cattedrauld. While the announcement concerning the matter has come from a source so well-informed as to be almost authentic. The matter was referred to at last Saturday's meeting of the Waterford County Council. At that time Mr. H. R. Dowd, the local representative who has been actively associated with the factory, said that the people of the Lismore area had been misled and surprised by the news that the factory was to go to Cattedrauld and that the County was the Secretary of the project behind the project. At last week's meeting of Waterford County Council in Dungarvan a letter was read from the Department of Health inviting the Council to consider the proposal for the establishment of the Waterford Health Authority. When Mr. T. Lannon asked about the negotiations that were to take place between the Council and the Corporation on the basis of future contributions to a valuation or population basis, the County Manager Mr. S. J. Moynihan said that preliminary discussions had opened but it was not necessary to hold the negotiations until after the authority was established. Mr. N. Walsh said that the Council was up against it and all they could hope for was the best bargain. When Mr. S. Lynch criticised the delay in reaching agreement, the County Manager said that the Corporation already knew what they could not prepare all the facts and figures necessary to make a sound financial year on March 31.
