**BRICKY DRAINAGE**  
The farmers of the Bricky Valley are again on the move in an effort to get the problem of the tidal flooding of large portions of their land, which has beset them for so long, solved. In the past efforts towards the same end have not brought the desired results but now fresh hopes have been raised that the problem will be solved.  
Most of those concerned are farmers, whose every acre counts. They are most industrious men who deserve every help and co-operation. In an area of such extensive cultivation it is nothing short of a miracle that almost 1,000 acres of land are affected by this flooding—500 directly and 500 more indirectly.  
The County Waterford Committee of Agriculture and the County Council, themselves unable to help in a material way have given the suggestion to put a sluice-gate which is accepted as the solution to the problem in the bridge at Kilmottorterry, where the Bricky river enters the County Council's jurisdiction. Only one member has expressed an objection on the grounds that the sluice would cause greater pressure on the embankment of the lands on the sea-side of the bridge. I do not believe that such an argument can be sustained as the erosion of the sluice would not in my mind increase the existing pressure by a fraction of a pound or raise the height of the water by an infinitesimal portion of an inch.




