Lismore Man For Trial On Murder Charge Witness Relates Incidents Between Accused and Deceased

Michael Langford, of 6, Church Street, Lismore, a 22-year-old farm labourer, was, at the end of a day-long sitting at Lismore District Court on Monday last, returned for trial to the Central Criminal Court in Dublin by District Justice J. B. Skinner, charged with the murder of Sean O'Farrell (64) bachelor farmer, Ashbourne House, Lismore, on Sunday, March 19 last.

At the conclusion of the depositions the Justice rejected an application from Mr. M. W. Keller, Solicitor, for the accused to refuse informations in the case. When the Justice read the charge to the accused, who at the time stood with his hands behind his back, he asked him if he had anything to say, the accused shook his head and replied "no, your honour."

In all, depositions were taken from 24 witnesses at last Monday's hearing. The day he sat in court on the previous week. The exhibits included a double-barrel shot-gun, cartridges and spent cartridge cases, a pocket watch, photographs, and the clothing worn by the deceased on the occasion of his murder. The exhibits were placed before the court.

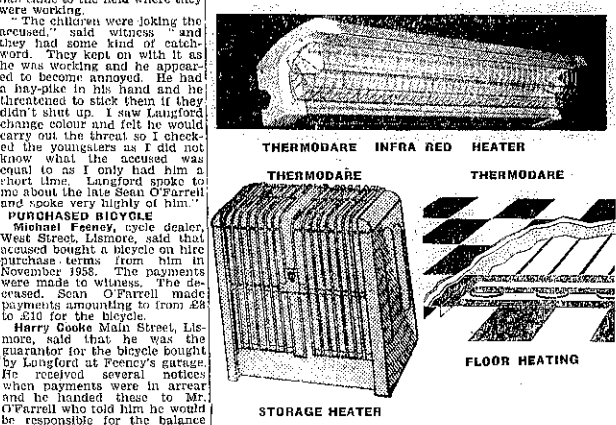
The accused, dressed in a dark tweed overcoat, arrived in the dock, handcuffed to one of his two plain-clothes escorts, through the day he sat in a chair to the right of the Justice's bench with his hands cuffed for the most part of the time in his right hand and his left hand in the pocket of his overcoat.

Before the Justice read the completion of the case, Mr. Keller and Dr. R. Cunningham, State Solicitor, who with Superintendent M. Costello, Dungarvan District Justice, were sitting late to complete the hearing. Much credit for the expedition of the trial was taken and reduced to writing is due to the Garda Inspector in which all Garda O'Keefe, District Court Clerk, who was assisted in writing the depositions by Garda S. Cronin, Dungarvan.

INCIDENT OVER SAW BLADE Desmond Langford (19) brother of the accused, was the first witness called on Monday, and he deposed that he and his mother, two brothers and sister, his father Percy Langford is in the Garda hospital at the moment. About 14 or 15 months ago, he and his brother Michael were in Ashbourne House, Lismore, when they were friendly with the O'Farrells. Michael had a saw blade in his pocket and on a subsequent occasion when he was at the house again and cutting down a hedge, some words passed between Michael and O'Farrell and O'Farrell went for him with the saw blade. He made a run at Michael as if he was going to hit him with the fork. He went for a stick and the row stopped.

SAW BROTHER DRIVING STATION WAGON "I remember March 19 last," said witness and for some weeks previous to that date my brother was employed at Dr. A. O'Farrell's at Ashbourne House, Lismore, on Sunday morning March 19, I left my house at about 10.30 a.m. I saw my brother before I left. He was up and about at the time and was quite normal. He was talking about going to Waterford that day to see my father and said

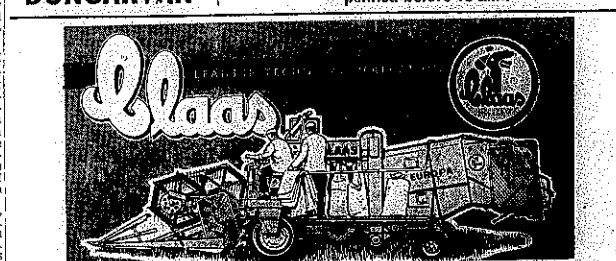
