## VACCINATION AGAINST POLIOMYELITIS

### Waterford Health Authority

Vaccination is available FREE OF CHARGE for:—  
(1) Persons in the LOWER INCOME GROUP who are  
(a) between the ages of six months and 40 years (i.e. persons born between 1st April, 1921, and 1st November, 1960),  
(b) expectant mothers.

(2) Persons in the MIDDLE INCOME GROUP who are between the ages of six months and 40 years (as stated above) who are:  
(a) staffs of all hospitals, clinics and homes (including ambulance drivers) and their families;  
(b) other practising nurses (not engaged solely in private practice) and their families;  
(c) medical and dental students and dental attendants and their families;  
(d) teachers and their families; and  
(e) other public health staff who might come in contact with poliomyelitis cases, and their families.

Vaccination is available on a PAYMENT BASIS for:—  
Persons in the MIDDLE INCOME GROUP, between the ages of six months and 40 years, who are not included in the above categories.

Application forms may be had at local dispensaries or direct from the Secretary, Waterford Health Authority, Arus Brugha, Dungarvan. Completed forms, and where necessary, appropriate payment, should be sent to the Secretary, Waterford Health Authority, Arus Brugha, Dungarvan. The latest date for receipt of completed application forms is 23rd May, 1961.

Parents, guardians and others concerned are urged to apply NOW for vaccination as no further scheme is contemplated this year.
