BOVINE TUBERCULOSIS ERADICATION SCHEME

UNDER THE BOVINE TUBERCULOSIS

it is an offence to hold a public sale of 14-day tested catcle save in premises approved by the Minister for Agriculture for the purpose, or

to expose cattle for public sale as 14-day tested save in approved premises.

14-day tested cattle exposed at a public sale must be properly tagged and certified.

From 1st October, 1961, the only cattle which may appear at any approved sale of 16-day tested cattle in the six authern delrying caunties of Cotk, Kerry, Kilkenny, Limeritk, Tippearay and Waterford, or in Co. Deblin, are (1) 16-day tested, (2) blue-chd, and (3) attested animals which by arrangement with the local B.T.E. Office are offered as the equivalent of 16-day tested, by the Clearance Area, in addition to these three classes, cattle which are tagged to show that they have passed a clearance test, may, subject to sultable segregation, appear at such a sale.

THESE REGULATIONS apply to both fairs and marts but not to the sale by a farmer of his own cattle on his own farm.
