INQUEST STORY OF DUNGARVAN MAN'S TRAGIC DEATH

PLUMBER'S THIRTY FEET SCAFFOLD FALL

The tragic story of how 58-year-old Dungarvan plumber, James Mullins, 7, Connolly Row, met his death when he fell from a 30-foot high, tubular steel scaffold which he was dismantling on Wednesday, September 27, having completed a job on the roof of the premises of Mr. E. Fleming at Grennan Square, was detailed at an inquest held by Dr. D. Hanly, Lismore, Coroner, sitting with a jury at the Town Hall, Dungarvan, on last Saturday evening.

BOVINE TUBERCULOSIS ERADICATION SCHEME

CONTROL OF CATTLE SALES

Important Notice to Promoters of Cattle Sales and Sellers of Stock

UNDER THE BOVINE TUBERCULOSIS (14-DAY TEST) ORDER, 1960—

- (a) It is an offence to hold a public sale of 14-day tested cattle save in premises approved by the Minister for Agriculture for the purpose, or
(b) to expose cattle for public sale as 14-day tested save in approved premises.
(c) 14-day tested cattle exposed at a public sale must be properly tagged and certified.

NOTE WELL—

From 1st October, 1961, the only cattle which may appear at any approved sale of 14-day tested cattle in the six southern dalying counties of Cork, Kerry, Kilkenny, Limerick, Tipperary and Waterford, or in Co. Dublin, are (1) 14-day tested, (2) Blue-card, and (3) attested animals which by arrangement with the local B.T.E. Office are offered as the equivalent of 14-day tested.
