A Regional Water Scheme costing £2,800,000 minimum has been passed by Waterford County Council at a recent meeting of that body. At a subsequent meeting the County Council stated that they did not realise they had passed it saying they only approved of it in principle. Officials said it was passed, whereupon the Chairman proposed that it be rescinded. The County Manager asked that the rescinding motion be held over until such time as a sub-committee of the County Council meet a sub-committee of the rural

organisations to discuss the Scheme. This meeting will take place on Thursday, 30th November, and the rural organisations represented will be N.F.A., Macra Na Feirme, I.C.A. and Muintir na Tire. On Monday, 11th December the County Council will meet again and will hear the result of this meeting. In order that the County Council may be in no doubt as to the attitude of all County Waterford farmers towards the Regional Water Scheme, the Waterford County Executive of the N.F.A. are planning a MONSTER

MEETING to be held in DUNGARVAN on the afternoon of MONDAY, 11th DECEMBER, and expect that every farmer and ratepayer who can do so will attend this meeting. N.F.A. has been taking the lead by giving the public the facts on this extravagant scheme. **THERE WILL BE REVOLUTION WARNS BOARD MEMBER**  
£17,000 Wage Increase Bill For Health Authority

As on most occasions since the Health Authority came into being the monthly meeting at Dungarvan on Monday last spent most of its time discussing demands for further wage increases. Before the Authority was a bill for £17,432 to pay increases to nurses, attendants, cooks and other employees in the Authority's general hospitals and mental hospital. The increase also covered tradesmen and labourers, health nurses, health inspectors, ambulance drivers, midwives and dispensary caretakers.

**LABOUR CONTENT OF DUNGARVAN HOUSING SCHEME**  
Unemployed Men's Deputation Before Council

A deputation representing unemployed labourers in Dungarvan appeared before last Friday night's meeting of the Town Council asking that something be done to provide work for them before Christmas. Mr. Patrick (Mackey) Prendergast, 14, Congress Villas, who acted as spokesman for the deputation said that there were about 60 or 70 unemployed men in Dungarvan at present and there appeared to be nothing doing to provide them with work for Christmas. When they went ahead and had the houses built, they would have to go to the country the number of labourers now employed was very small as

the work was mostly mechanical. That was the thing they were really up against. Regarding the allegation that the Contractor was to sublet the contract, Mr. Kyne said that he was quite entitled to do this and it was a common practice to do so. Mr. Kennedy said that the Chairman of the Council should recommend to the Contractor that he take on more men if possible and to recommend to the men on the deputation that they go back to their Union with their problems.
