BEHIND THE SPOTLIGHT

THE SPIRIT OF CHRISTMAS
I think that it would be in the worst of taste for anyone to suggest that the bulk of the people of Ireland find the true significance of the great festival of the Nativity. I have never thought this aspect as have never been conscious of more stress being laid on the materialistic side. Five times have changed and even though we are supposed to change with them I believe that the festive mood which is in everyone of us to some degree always comes in the turning of the Season of Good-will.

In Dungarvan as in the other towns throughout the wide areas in which this paper circulates, the tendency in later years is to lay more stress on the materialistic side. In practically every shop window in the Old Quay the centre-piece of the Christmas displays is the crib showing the Holy Family as we imagine them on that first Christmas Night.

In the homes too where the children look forward to Santa Claus and spend such a happy time decorating the traditional Christmas tree with tinsel, baubles and dangles a crib is always evident to show that the celebrations go to mark the birth of the Infant Jesus. Perhaps in lands other than Ireland there is a need to warn against what has been called the dechristianising effects of Christmas trees and Santas. But for us there is a symbolism in the Christmas Tree. The evergreen fir taken to signify the life of life: the candles and lights placed on its branches represent the Light of the World and the gifts which are placed on it depict for us the great gift God bestowed on His Son to us.

No matter what has been said, I would not like to see the old customs of Christmas die out. They are mostly family customs in which parents and children are closely knit together in making for each other memories which are hallowed as long as life lasts.

Christmas is the Birthday of Christ. It is a time of peace, happiness and goodwill. It is a time when each and everyone of us tries to do his duty and to come closer together. It is a time of joy and contentment. It is a time when we come close to God and to our neighbour. That is the true spirit of the great occasion and with this thought I extend to all my readers best wishes for a very Holy and Happy Christmas.
