Of the large family of Warblers the Reed Warbler builds by far the most interesting home for its young. It is a tiny bird — one of the smallest and very shy, but its nest is a masterpiece of construction and camouflage. The mother bird chooses three or four strong reeds grouped together and uses them as a frame on which she proceeds to weave a basket-like nest, using for material old reeds and grasses. When the weaving is finished the nest is lined with the soft dead flowers of last year's reeds. This cosy nest, standing on stilts above the water and toning with the background, moves with every wind but is deep enough to prevent the eggs from spilling out in the strongest gale and to conceal the hatching hen.
