## STREET FAIRS SHOULD END

Last week I carried an extract from an article in the 'Sunday Times' supplement which showed Dungarvan up in a bad light. It referred to the impression caused by the general condition of the town resulting from the holding of the monthly fairs on the streets. Unfortunately, I must agree that what was stated in the article was perfectly true. There have been times out of number when shop-keepers and business people have found their way into their premises barred by cattle and sheep, while pedestrians who venture out on foot day do so at their own risk. For motorists it is a test of skill and patience endeavour to negotiate the streets on such occasions. Farmers and drovers who take up special 'stands' absolutely refuse to move themselves or their animals to allow traffic to pass. In wet weather the roads and streets just become morasses which prove a hazard to walk on.  
My question throughout the years we have, perhaps, got somewhat used to these conditions, but it is only when we reflect on the impressions they give a stranger that we suddenly realise what they really mean.  
I think that it is high time to move the fairs from the streets altogether. They are a danger from the point of view of traffic, not to mention public health. The argument has been used in their favour in the past that the removal of the fairs would mean a big loss to the business of the town. I do not subscribe to this line of thought.
