**WHAT WILL IT MEAN**

No one as yet knows what the implications of the new tax will mean to the public. The Health Authority which administers all the hospitals in the County and City will pay almost £125,000 this year for food, clothing, furniture, medicines and medical appliances, not to mention other supplies. The tax it levied on this amount would run into over £2,000. This is the County Council. The Engineering Department alone has an expenditure running into over £200,000, a big portion of which goes out in the purchase of machinery, road materials, office equipment, etc. etc. while the other departments also spend thousands of pounds on the purchase of various materials. The addition of the tax to these huge sums will run into a big amount and will burden the rates.

It is all very true for the politicians to be playing games with each other in Leinster House but the public are very concerned about this tax and with justification seek clarification of the matter.

A great deal of agitation has taken place in recent years to have the contribution to Health Charges made from rates reduced from 50 per cent. to 25 per cent. It is that the Government should bear 75 per cent of the cost. Apparently the Minister for Health has now decided that he will no longer listen to such representations because the turn-over tax contribution, the local contribution, is to be increased by a further 2 1/2 per cent. ## Cappoquin Priest To Celebrate Jubilee In Ontario

Classmates Will Assist At Special High Mass

When Rev. Fr. Michael F. Ahearne, Pastor of Blessed Sacrament Parish, Ontario, celebrates the Silver Jubilee of his ordination to the priesthood in Ontario next Tuesday, May 14, a special Solemn High Mass in honour of the great occasion will be celebrated at his parish church at which two former classmates who studied with him at Mount Mellary Seminary in the early 1930's will be assistant priests, while a third will deliver the sermon.

Fr. Ahearne who is son of the late William and Honora Ahearne (nee Barrett, Bellin-taylor) of Main Street, Cappoquin, was educated at the Christian Brothers' School, Lismore, before commencing his philosophical studies at Mount Mellary. In September 1934 he entered St. John's College, Waterford where he commenced the study of theology and four years later on June 16, 1938, (Feast of Corpus Christi) he was ordained to the priesthood for the American Mission by His Lordship, Most Rev. Dr. Jeremiah Kinnane, Bishop of Waterford.

He left for the United States in August 1938 and was appointed as Assistant at Sacred Heart Parish, Klamath Falls. A year later he went as administrator to the Parish of St. Carmel, Chillicothe, where for nine years he laboured among the Indians. In 1948, on February 15, he was appointed Pastor of St. Thomas Parish, Richmond, where he did a great deal of work building a new church and new hall besides attending to his many Pastoral duties. The new church was built in 1950 and in 1959 the new hall was erected.

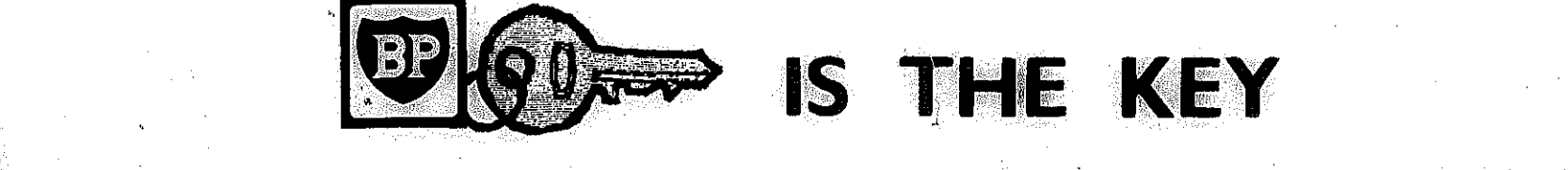

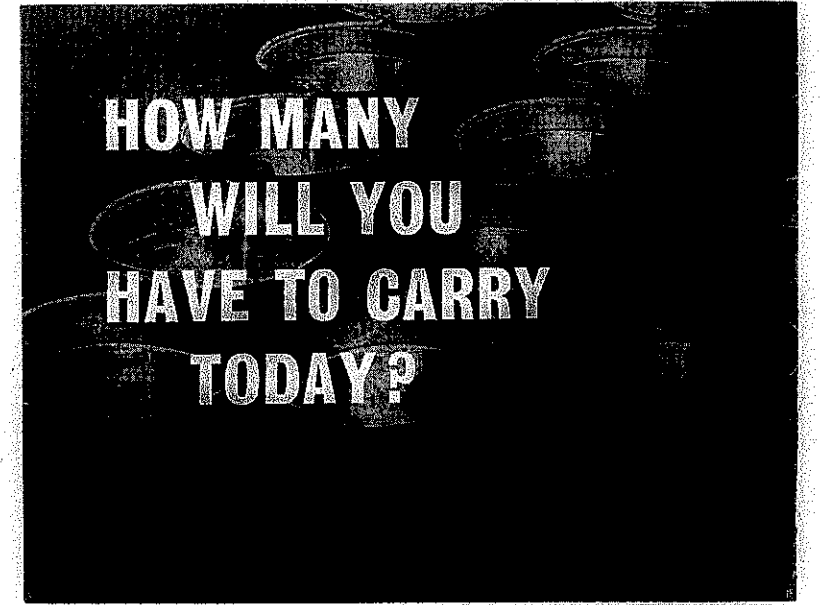
