Modeligo Motor Cyclist's Death

Tragic Details Disclosed At Inquest

A verdict in accordance with the Medical evidence, that death was due to shock and damage to the brain, was returned at an inquest in Dungarvan on Saturday last before Dr. T. McMahon, Cappoquin, Deputy Coroner, on Edward O'Keefe (19), Churchquarter, Modeligo, who was fatally injured in the early hours of Monday morning, July 8th.

Mr. William O'Keefe, father of the deceased, said his son Edward was riding a motor-cycle on the road near Modeligo on the night of July 7th. He was riding at a speed of about 40 m.p.h. when he was struck by a lorry. The lorry was carrying a load of bricks and was travelling in the same direction as the motor-cycle. The lorry driver was not aware of the motor-cycle and did not see it until it was too late to avoid a collision.

DEEPLY UNCONSCIOUS

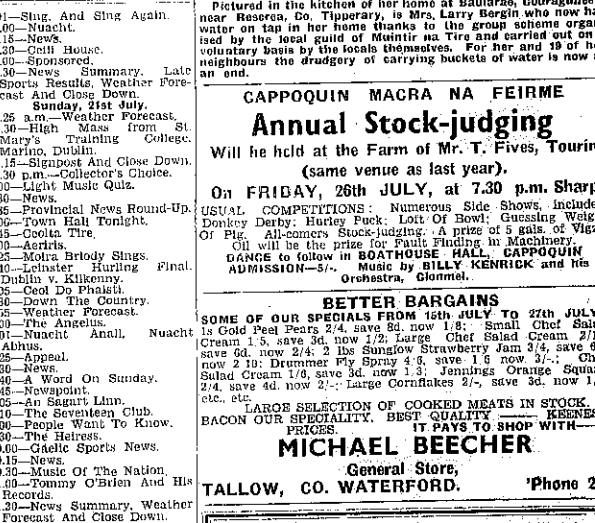
