Department Of Social Welfare CHILDREN'S ALLOWANCES

UNILUREN'S ALLOWANCES
In accordance with the Social Welfare (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act, 1963, a children's allowance at the rate of 191- a
month will be payable as from the 1st November, 1953, in respect
of the first or only qualified child in a family.

Heads of families with only one child-ander 1st years of age


