ROAD EXPENDITURE AND GRANTS
The Troiloch has come out and in a letter to the employers' and workers' organisations has given the green light for the fifth round of salary increases. In his letter Mr. Lemass states: "In the confident expectation that the country's present rate of economic growth will be maintained in the future, the Government's policy of maintaining the real wage level is being pursued. A further upward revision of wages and salaries might now be safely envisaged on a scale which would provide compensation for all wage and salary earners through whatever rise in the general price level might follow on the introduction of the new tax and social contributions to such further extent as would represent their fair share of the estimated expansion of national resources in the coming year."

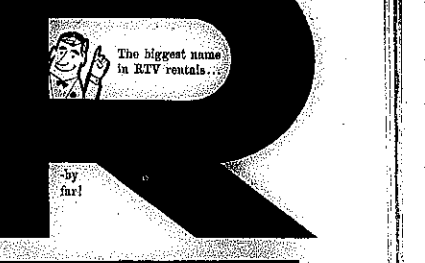
