BIG RATE JUMP
On tomorrow (Friday) members of the County Council will meet in Dungarvan to consider the estimates for running the various public services in the county for the coming year. The bill prepared by the committee of the Council and already vetted by the Council's Estimates Sub-Committee is a most formidable one and calls for a rate of 52/3d in the £, an increase of 3/9d over the current rate of 48/6d.

URBAN PROSPECTS

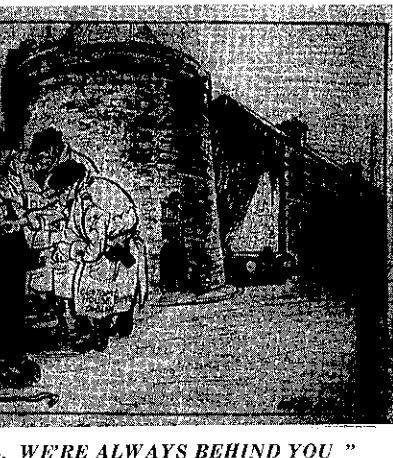

PRaise FOR QUALITY EXHIBITS AT MARE SHOWS

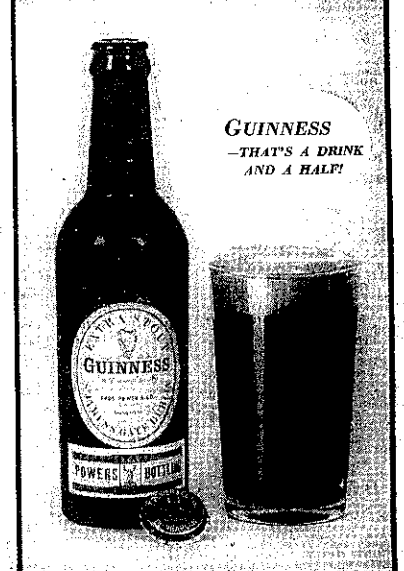

INCREASED GRANTS WOULD ENCOURAGE PRIVATE TREE PLANTING

Plans for Co. Waterford Arbor Day

Plans for Arbor Day in the county were mentioned at the monthly meeting of the County Waterfords Committee of Agriculture in Dungarvan last Saturday, when the C.A.O. Mr. P. J. Moran, Chairman of the Committee, announced that the Department of Lands and Forests had announced that the Government would mark the occasion by the planting of one-acre plots of trees at the farm of Mr. J. Quirk, Kilbrien Hall, Ballyduff, on Saturday, February 23rd.

The C.A.O. added that two other plots are at Mr. Kelly's farm at Old Parish, and the other at Mr. Dalton's farm, Kilmossarty, would also be planted at a later stage.

Officials of the Committee would assist at the planting ceremony at Ballyduff which would be fully covered by Press and T.V. publicity. It is expected that Mr. Brian Lennihan, Parliamentary Secretary to the Minister, will attend the function.

When Mr. W. Foran asked what the idea behind the planting of these plots was, the C.A.O. replied that it was aimed at popularising private tree planting in Dungarvan last Saturday, when the C.A.O. Mr. P. J. Moran, Chairman of the Committee, announced that the Department of Lands and Forests had announced that the Government would mark the occasion by the planting of one-acre plots of trees at the farm of Mr. J. Quirk, Kilbrien Hall, Ballyduff, on Saturday, February 23rd.

Mr. Moran said that he was very interested in private tree planting and had planted three acres of trees on his own farm. Some years ago he had proposed that the initial instalment of the grant should be increased from £10 to £18, while the balance of £5 could be paid in 9 years to ensure that the plantation was properly cared for in the meantime.

"If this was done," said Mr. Moran, "it would provide a greater incentive to farmers to plant more trees on their holdings and would get more of this kind of work done."

Mr. J. Doherty thought the £20 planting grant was too small and it offered no encouragement to farmers to plant more trees.

The proposal was passed unanimously.
