## PENSMAN takes you Behind the Spotlight

**THE HORNS OF A DILEMMA**  
What has now come to be known as the Annual Battle of the Rates is at present in progress. The first round ended inconclusively last Friday when after a three-hour session the members of the County Council in a sort of desperate and restricted manner decided to defer further consideration of the estimates for ten days to sort themselves out. A full report of the proceedings can be read elsewhere in this issue and this shows that an increase of 3/9d. over last year's rate of 48/6d. is being sought. A deputation from the County Executive of the N.F.A. went to the meeting and in the words of their leading spokesman, Mr. D. J. Coghlan, their presence there was to remind the Council that the problem of ever-increasing rates still existed.

For more than an hour the members of the deputation in measured and reasoned arguments pointed out to the members the urgent need to keep the burden of rates at a reasonable level. They pointed out that the main reason for the present almost intolerable level of rates (the county rate in 1959 was 48/6d. and in 1964 it is 52/3d.) was the inclusion of the charges for Health Services and Main Roads. This of course was patently obvious from the fact that the proposed rate of 52/3d. was the combined cost of these two services came to more than half the total and that they were responsible for most of the 3/9d. increase being asked for this year.

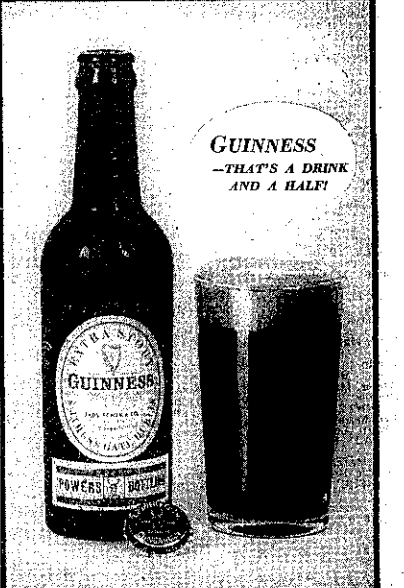
**RATES ON LAND**  
Mr. Moynihan at the conclusion of his report made the following observations: "To assist the Council in an appraisal of the position as it affects the Rates, I have had abstracted from the Council's records the figures for the current year which show that out of a total of 2,404,000 (including arrears of 23,871) a sum of 2,142,800 was leviable as Rates on Buildings in the County, the balance being charged on Land. The gross Rate on Land amounted to 2,505,810 (including 238,651 exclusive of Agricultural Grant amounting to the net Rate payable in respect of Land in the County of about 2,267,159. This means that the net Rate payable in respect of Land in the County is about 21% of the Rate struck by the Council. Accordingly the County may be in mind that on the average, the landholder pays Rates equivalent to 21% of the net Rate. The Agricultural Grants amounts to 70% of the general Rate in respect of the first 250 Valuation, an Employment Allowance of 21% in respect of each eligible male worker, together with a supplementary allowance equivalent to 25% of the Rate in the Found on valuation over 250 with a proviso that the latter two concessions do not amount to more than the full rate applicable to such part of the valuation."
