BALLYDUFF EN FETE FOR TREE PLANTING CEREMONIES

Roadside Demonstration Plot to Encourage Private Planting
 The picturesque village of Ballyduff overlooking the Ballyduff Water was on fete last Saturday evening as a big crowd converged on it for the special tree planting demonstration which is part of a scheme sponsored by the Trees for Ireland Organisation and the Forestry Department of the Government.

The weather too was perfect and the sun shone on the big crowd which gathered on the roadside at Inchineeny, a few miles from the village. Overlooking the main Fermoy-Waterford road, on the lands of Mr. James Quirk, hundreds of young trees were already planted and the job was completed on Saturday evening before a battery of televisions and press cameras.

Very Rev. P. Farrell, P.P., President of the Ballyduff Parish Council, welcomed all to the ceremony and thanked the Trees for Ireland Organisation and the Forestry Department of the Government for sponsoring the scheme which is being carried out in other counties. He thanked the local voluntary organisations and local bodies for their co-operation and especially the Muintir na Tíre branch for planting the plot at their disposal.
