

HOW TO APPLY ARTIFICIAL RESPIRATION BY MOUTH TO MOUTH METHOD IN FOUR EASY STAGES

Near-drowning and severe electric shock cause unconsciousness and a stoppage of breathing. The mouth-tomouth method described here can restore breathing and save a life. It is essential that it be started as soon as possible after recovering or discovering the victim. In the case of electric shock, power must be switched off





INSERT THUMB IN MOUTH AND LIFT JAW

In Step Two, insert a thumb between the victim's teeth, grasping the lower jaw at the middle and lifting the lower jaw forcefully upwards so that the lower teeth are higher than the upper teeth.





BLOW INTO MOUTH 12 TIMES PER MINUTE

In Step Four, take a deep breath and place the mouth over the victim's mouth with airtight contact. Then blow into the victim's mouth, forcefully for adults, gently for children.

The victim's chest should be watched, and as soon as it rises, the blowing should be stopped and the operator's mouth quickly removed from the mouth of the victim, allowing the victim to exhale passively. If the chest does not rise, the support of the victim's head (Step 2) should be improved and the blowing done more forcefully. The cycle of inflation and exhalation should be repeated 12 times per minute for adults and 20 times per minute for infants and small children. Note that on an infant, the mouth should be placed over the child's mouth and nose. This method of artificial respiration is very suitable for treatment of the victims of electric shock or drowning.
