But It Was West Waterford's Ballyduff

Ballyduff Upper 3-5 Ballyduff Lower 3-5 Short a man and facing a two points deficit with only twelve minutes of the hour left Ballyduff Upper rose to magnificent heights to overcome an almost insurmountable challenge when in the last blistering ten minutes they blattered a well deserved two points victory over the other Ballyduff to take the County's first Intermediate hurling County title to the West.

They had very good defenders in Joe Daly, Paddy Quirk, Mick Caplan and Dave Barry, while John O'Gorman, centre, restored Quirk was sent to the sick.

MIRACULOUS SAVE

Just before the call of time it seemed inevitable that the Eastern side would save the day as the bustling Tom Cheasty broke his way through a wall of defenders and from about fifteen yards out lashed in a rasping which had goal written all over it. It looked all over and many a heart must have nearly stopped as the bullet-like drive went straight for the net. But standing between the winners and almost certain defeat was full-back Joe Daly who capped a wonderful display when he miraculously stopped the shot and cleared. It was the Eastern side's final bid. Shortly afterwards the final whistle went and Ballyduff Upper were worthy champions.
