A WAY OUT During a brief discussion on new bye-laws covering pedestrian traffic, cyclists and pedestrians, the Report of the Commission on Traffic, Cyclists and Pedestrians, after the Chairman, Mr. T. D. Walsh, had referred to the latter, further information was given from the County Council that some effort is to be made to interest in the scheme number 31 which states: "A person in charge of an animal which is a pest or dangerous to man, may be required to pay so much as the cost of its removal." It was also stated that an ex-emption would be given to those who take all reasonable steps to allow the Council to take care of the animal does not obstruct other traffic.
