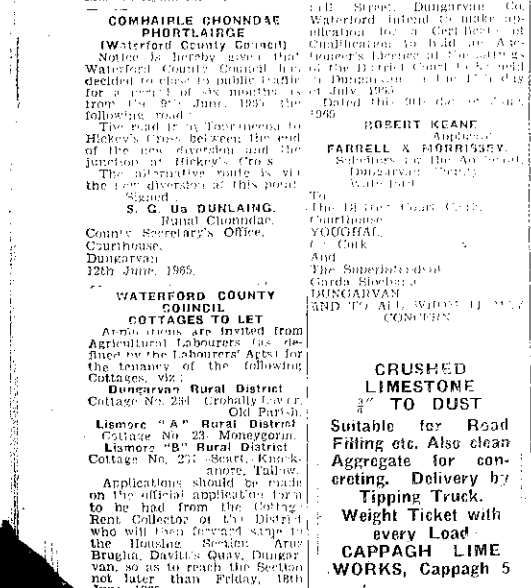

WATERFORD SNATCH LATE VICTORY
Midfield Problems Solved - Attack Poses New Ones
Waterford 3-2, Limerick 2-0.
