**FACING THE FACTS**

An invitation, by circular and notice in the local papers, has gone out from the County Council to every interested organization and party in the county to attend a public meeting at the Courthouse, Dungarvan, to-night (Thursday) at 8 p.m. for the purpose of formulating plans for the forthcoming pre-Christmas Road Safety Campaign which will be launched on a nationwide basis by the Minister for Local Government during the first week of December.

Road Safety is everyone's business and it is to be expected then, that every responsible person who can will show his interest in the campaign by personally attending this meeting.

I am sure that anybody who makes a habit of reading the newspapers with their continuous stream of sad reports and horrifying pictures of road accidents might be tempted to shrug his shoulders and ask "Is there any such thing as road safety?" Certainly there is, and the success of some of the more recent campaigns in this field has proved that. Equally so will those who read the papers be struck by the big number of drunken driving cases which come before the courts and for which an automatic suspension follows for small quantities of alcohol.

Drunken drivers are one of the most dangerous hazards on the roads at the present time and it must be remembered that people need not be "dead drunk" to be judged incapable of driving. Have you ever stopped to think what happens when you take a drink? The alcohol passes through your blood stream, and thence to your brain, which it affects in a certain way. It "depresses" the higher centres of the brain and reduces or removes their control over the lower centres. That can be very pleasant if "relaxes" you. The controls and cautions which keep you on the safe side are relaxed and you behave more "naturally," enjoy yourself.

But you're not right for driving those drinks have affected your judgment and attention and you don't realise that simply because they are so affected. You can still manage the controls of the car perfectly, your braking and steering may be quite good, but you won't be able to face up to the sudden emergency to realise in time that it is developing and to judge in time what to do.
