PENSMAN takes you Behind the Spotlight

FOR A FORTNIGHT AT LEAST

The National Pre-Christmas Road Safety Campaign, which commenced on Wednesday of this week and will continue until Saturday week, December 11. All local bodies are participating in the campaign which is aimed at showing down the ever-mounting figures which tell the tragic story of the wholesale slaughter that now takes place on Irish roads every year. One of the main features of the campaign is that under which garages in all areas will operate a free vehicle check scheme to alert drivers to the dangers of defective vehicles and the hazards of winter driving. It could mean a big drop in the accident figures. There is any possible chance that for at least the next fortnight the statistics sheets on which road fatalities are marked up are kept completely blank from a sophisticated society.

THE HAZARDS OF NIGHT DRIVING

As my contribution to the Safety Campaign, I would like to refer briefly to one aspect of driving which in my opinion is perhaps the most dangerous — night driving. Garda statistics show that during 1964 the largest number of accidents took place in the hours of darkness. It is a fact that 15 per cent. of all fatal road accidents, 1,333 other ac-

idents, 33 per cent. of this total. It must be remembered that traffic is much lighter at night time, so judging by the figures I have just quoted, your chance of having an accident is far greater in the night than in the day time. Now every driver has experienced the terror of "dazzle" while driving close behind a road spewer from time to time. So remember to have your head lamps well focused and operate them when your sense of direction is impaired. Keep them dipped. Keep them dipped. Keep them dipped. Other traffic in built-up areas and in fact if you are not already aware of it, this is a legal requirement where a driver is obliged to stop or slow down. If you are constantly overtaking or driving in a line, you must be on the look out for the sudden appearance of an oncoming vehicle or a pedestrian. The pedestrian is well advised to use a footpath wherever it is available. If there is none he should walk on the right-hand side of the road facing the oncoming traffic. The pedal cyclist is particularly vulnerable in a road accident. So it behoves him to have a good front lamp, a good rear lamp and a reliable reflector.

Unexpected Passing Of Well-Known Figure

The unexpected death of Mr. Nicholas Quealy, which occurred at his residence at Ballinacorney, Dungarvan, last Monday evening caused a profound shock and the news of his tragic passing was received everywhere with almost disbelief.

The late Nicholas Quealy was known and loved everywhere in the west. A great business man, a sound practical farmer, and a man who amassed a great deal of wealth in his lifetime, he remained all through an unassuming, mild and approachable. His sound advice was always available to help those who needed it and his wisdom and foresight helped to solve many problems and smooth the pathways of life for others.

He was a Rate Collector for Waterford County Council since 1917 and was principal of the Auctioneering firm of Quinley & Co., Dungarvan. He was Chairman of the Knockree Co-Op. for over 20 years, a Director of Clover Meats Ltd., and the Secretary of the Co. Waterford Shopkeepers Association, and Chairman of the Dungarvan Branch, Cork Co. Operative, Lister & Mears, which he played no small part in establishing. He had attended the cattle sales at the Mart throughout Monday and he had only arrived home when he became ill and died almost immediately.

In private life he was a kind and gentle man who always had a smile on his face. He was always active and devoted having to go to his work and to his home and to his family. He was a man of wide interests and was a daily communicant. As befitting the popularity he so richly deserved, the funeral was attended by one of the largest corteges ever seen in the district. It was drawn from all walks of life over a wide area and there was no professional class or social class which was not represented.

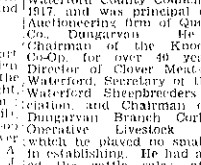
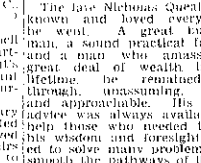
