Dungarvan Gala Week which proved such a wonderful social event in the town last year is in jeopardy because the Committee with the responsibility of organising it find that the financial resources at their disposal are inadequate. Despite the amount of money which the huge number of visitors to the Gala spent in the town last year the organising Committee's balance sheet showed a hefty debt balance. This is quite understandable when it is remembered that much of the entertainment and excellent stuff it all was free. Indeed only for the benevolence of the outside sponsors which the organisers succeeded in interesting in the Gala it would have been impossible to arrange such an ambitious programme without going further into the red.

FORTY-FIVE YEARS AGO

Forty-five years ago next Saturday or to be more exact on March 19, 1921, the Burgetty Ambush occurred on the main Dungarvan - Waterford road about a mile and a half out of the town. There in the early morning a group of the I.R.A. had an engagement with British Forces which included Buffs, Marines, Black and Tans and R.I.C. One of the tragic results of the ambush was the deaths of two brave Irish soldiers, Command. Pat Keating and Captain Sean Fitzgerald of the 2nd Connaught Battalion of the I.R.A. who lost their lives in the action. A monument now marks the spot where the ambush occurred and where the two gallant Connaught men gave their lives for Ireland in that early morning battle. The action is recalled in the following poem which has come to me from "N.C." of the 3rd Battalion:
Blow softly, winds blow,
Disturb not the rest
Who sleep in the Connaught
Their cradle of birth.
They died for their country
A nation enslaved.
The twin from the Connaught
Of the Deise Brigade
Blow softly, winds blow,
Disturb not a Gael.
Like the men at the Tiber
They stood and they dared.
At the Cross of Old Piltown,
And James Burgetty
The clerk of their rites
Was heard by the free.
In the hour of the Deise
In a Churchyard memory
Entwined in fond memory
