EMMETTS LOOKED LIKE MISSING THE BUS

Gaultier Defeated In Game Of Missed Chances

Emmetts 1-4; Gaultier 0-5. Emmets (Colligan) looked like missing the bus in their second round senior football championship game with Gaultier at the Father Field, Dungarvan, on Sunday last, because even though they were well in top territory, errors in the second half sent them forwards were pathetically weak and it was not until the final ten minutes that they managed to clinch the issue and score three which were not safe with their two points left banking precariously in the balance right to the final whistle.

Match Report. It was a game in which both sides missed many chances and Gaultier can claim to have been unfortunate when a close free kick by John Martin went wide. After a scoreless first period, Gaultier made a crucial period when the scores were level going into the final quarter.

Conditions Ideal. The football was anything but good, even though conditions were ideal for the game which attracted only a very small attendance.

Gaultier made off the run in the first half and led 4-0 to 0-1 after nineteen minutes.

EXPERIMENTING.

Emmetts who seemed to be experimenting with their line out had to make fast switches but the most effective of which was the transfer to Colm Baldwin, and Kilkrossant, played at Dungarvan, on Sunday night last to great effect with the ball passing from one end to another in the sector which had been lifeless up till then, and also got the best score of the game just three minutes from the interval. A goal was scored on a solo run from about fifty yards out and crashed the ball into the Gaultier net to leave the scores level at 1-1 in the interval.

Scored First. Gaultier again scored first after the turnover when they pointed out on a minute. Colm Baldwin, with his own hand, caused a foul, and the Gaultier half had control they failed to score again. Their second minute and were again until the 19th minute when they moved ahead by a trailing goal to 2-0. By now another point. Another foul on Colm Baldwin, and Kilkrossant, put on the 21st minute left them leading and bashed home a free kick to 3-0 to 0-3 and they had to play the rest of the game on the narrow lead against heavy pressure from Gaultier during the final five minutes.
