DOG'S ORDER, 1966. The Minister for Agriculture and Fisheries has made an Order, entitled as above, under the Diseases of Animals Act, 1966, requiring that every owner or other person in charge of a dog shall not permit the dog to be in any place other than the premises or land of the owner or person in charge, unless the dog is wearing a collar or harness with the name and address of the owner inscribed thereon or a plate or badge attached thereto. This requirement does not apply in respect of any dog while being used for hunting game, excluding rabbits or to any greyhounds either at a greyhound track or at an authorised coursing meeting, or to any pack of hounds or in respect of any dog while being used for police purposes by a member of the Garda Síochána. The Order also requires that every owner or person in charge of a dog shall during all of the hours between sunset and sunrise prevent the dog from straying by— (a) confining the dog in a building, shed, yard or other enclosure from which it cannot escape, (b) effectively securing the dog by collar and chain, or (c) accompanying the dog and keeping it under effective control. The Order will come into force on the 1st January, 1967, and will apply in respect of dogs in urban as well as rural areas.
