

GOST OF ROAD WIDENING AT DUNGARVAN HOUSING SCHEMES

Would Increase Rates By 6/8d.

Estimates for the widening of roadways in a number of housing schemes in Dungarvan submitted by the Town Engineer, Mr. P. Walsh, at a recent meeting of Dungarvan Urban Council totalled £4,850 and the Town Clerk, Mr. P. Doyle, told Mr. T. Lannen that if the work was to be carried out it would cost 6/8d. in the £ on the rates.

The Engineer's report gave the detailed costs as follows: Murphy Place £2,423; Caseyville £1,625 and the road from Caseyville to Cahill Bungalow Place £210.

Mr. T. Lannen asked: "aren't the roads in those places wide enough?"

Mr. R. Walsh then replied: "but that's too much money to do the job."

Mr. Lannen: "How did this crop up in the first place?"
