Excess Expenditure Payments by Dungarvan U.C. Approved

Dungarvan Urban Council at their monthly meeting in Dungarvan last Friday night, approved the proposal.

The proposal was seconded by Mr. N. Kelly, unanimously approved the over-expenditure of three heads of £482 made up as follows:

£100 for the personal representatives of T. Tomlin, an employee recently deceased; £238 for the replacement of Town Hall caretaker (due to illness) £100 cost of new typewriter for Clerk's Office £75.

It was pointed out that the over-expenditure would cost approximately £1,000 in the next year's rate.

HOUSING LOANS

The Council approved the raising of a supplementary loan of £1,000 to complete the second stage of houses at Boreenraha and Connetty.

The Town Clerk explained that the existing loan was for £264,000 but the final all-in cost had been £265,200.

The Council, on the proposal of Mr. N. Kelly, seconded by Mr. T. Lee, agreed to raise a loan of £19,200 to finance the building of 8 houses at Boreenraha Street, Abbeyside. This will include professional fees, etc. The approved Contractors for the scheme are Messrs. E. O'Brien & Sons, Abbeyside, who submitted a tender of £17,949 for the houses.

MAKE IT SAFE

Despite all the warnings about road fatalities and the advice to motorists to be more careful on the roads, the number of traffic accidents continues to mount. Every week-end especially, the tragic reports of death and mutilation make front page news on our daily newspapers.

Week-ends are proving to be a particularly dangerous time and the statistics in this regard go to show that it is during periods of relaxation and pleasure that the most serious accidents tend to occur.

It is somewhat surprising that after its long association with Christmas the reason for the presence or absence of berries is still not known to many. The belief that their absence indicates a severe winter is unfounded.

The fact is that holly produces two types of flowers—male and female—and each is borne on a different bush. An old poster, showing three two-masted schooners at Dunagavan quay was passed to me recently by Mr. Tommy Wade, Murphy Place, Abbeyside. Unfortunately the card has been so damaged by the passage of time that its reproduction is impossible. The view shows two of the schooners berthed at the quayside with a third on the ground. A close examination shows other sailing ships berthed further along the quay near Moloney's yard. Unfortunately the names of them were illegible. Mr. Wade's memory whose memory stretches back over the years, can recall the ships that sailed out of Dunagavan in those far off times. The Richard Condon, the Sarah Mary, Maria McMillen, Catherine Ellen, Village Hill, Peri, Three Gamul, Harvey, Maggie West, Acorn, Wigan and Parion which was the last. Incidentally we come again this week to another anniversary of the loss of the Moresby in Dunagavan Bay on Christmas Eve 1895.

**President's Christmas Message**

**N.F.A. TO INTENSIFY CAMPAIGN**  
 "The N.F.A. is being forced to intensify its campaign because of the indifference of the Government to the serious position of farmers," said Mr Tom Fingean, Chairman of the N.F.A. regional group following a meeting of the Carpark Group and of the Sillings Group in N.F.A. House last week.  
 "We have received no decision on our proposals for decentralisation of the Department and the Minister for Agriculture has refused to consider as a matter of urgency on November 21st 22 days ago," Mr Fingean continued. "An organised group would have been as patient or as reasonably as we have been in the past. We have suffered a serious loss in income this year," he said. "We now have an alternative but to make a friend would scrap his plan."  
 Mr Fingean said that the Government is being advised of our plans for further action to be implemented shortly.  
 "Our Demonstrations Group is holding an early meeting to discuss the possibility of a small farmers' strike for the next few days. It is necessary for the total obstruction of progressive and constructive discussion and resistance to agriculture rests squarely with the Government."  
 Support for our campaign has been requested from small farmers, which was received on December 9th from Mr Sean McElroy, Secretary of the Deerpark, Co. Wick, and Mr J. J. McDev, C.C. of Glencolumbkille, Co. Wick.  
 "A worthwhile development that is being rapidly taken place would be that a certain group of breeders could sell on a contract basis to another group of fatteners. In this way these breeders could be made on a contract basis to perform with obvious advantages to all concerned."  
 Compared with many other competitor countries, there is considerable scope for improvement in the information and assistance available to our pig producers. It is very relevant to mention here that a more intensive pig advisory service is being needed in Ireland.  
**IS THIS ASKING TOO MUCH?**  
 "There is an immediate need for a national examination of the conscience on the small farm problem in Ireland," said Mr T. Llewellyn, Secretary of the Rural Development Committee of N.F.A. at a meeting in University College, Dublin, last week.  
 "At present this problem is ignored by the population at large. When it is considered it is in too often done in a purely emotional way. Farmers on small holdings and their families are spoken of as though they were flies in the ointment of national planning—meritless little considerations."  
 "It is ridiculous," said Mr Llewellyn, "for anyone to try to drop the small farmer from the farmer and his family. It is madness to talk of structural reform without giving any thought to the human beings concerned. The farmers themselves must get priority in any structural reform."  
 "It was silly," he said, "to take as though it were possible for the farmer to sell his land and to build in every area to make a decent living from farming. It is high time that people said in public the things they say in the head. Right now there is a need for honesty especially in public debate on this subject for and against the retention of the maximum number of small farmers in our society. It is not enough to say a word of thanks to those who have so much to give to the country in so many different ways.
