COUNCIL'S PLANS FOR HOUSING AND SEWERAGE DEVELOPMENT AT ABBEYSIDE
At a special meeting of Dungarvan Urban Council last Friday night the Town Clerk, Mr. P. Doyle, submitted proposals for housing and sewerage development at Abbeyside.

Mr. Doyle reported that during the previous week he had a discussion with the Manager and Town Engineer in regard to the housing plan for Abbeyside. The original plan submitted some time ago by the Architects was estimated to cost £2,500 but the Manager considered this figure too high. This plan provided for a five grade in the living room and a converted type of all heating in the kitchen and dining room. The type of fuel to be used would be mainly coke or anthracite but it was considered that this type of fuel would be costly on the tenants and concern was also expressed as to whether there would be adequate heat provided.

Having been asked, the Architects submitted amended proposals for an ordinary type boiler grate to heat the kitchen and dining room area with an estimated cost of £1,500. This plan would reduce the estimate per house by £1,000 to £1,500.

Mr. Doyle said that the Town Engineer was satisfied with the amended plan which the Manager now recommended subject to the sanction of the Department. It was not anticipated that there would be any delay in the completion of the plan. On the proposal of Mr. T. Kynne, T.D., Chairman, seconded by Mr. W. Walsh, the Council approved of the amended plan. Referring to future plans, the Manager, Mr. P. Doyle, pointed out that they had received land for further development.
