





Offenders are liable to prosecution and to payment of empensation for any damage caused.

Farmers who inlend to carry out moor hurnings this year within one mile of State plantations are therefore warmed in their own interests to give advance notice to the Forester-in-Charge and to the Gardal.

Foresters will co-operate to the fullish possible extent to ensure that such burnings may be carried out without damage to plantations.






