



good management.
For healthy, thriving calves watch these points:

Make sure they get blestings for the first few days after birth. Feed milk at body temperature and feed at least three times a day.

Thoroughly clean and disinfect each pen after the calf leaves it and before any other calf is put into it.

Prevent draughts, dampness and changes of temperature.

• Isolate immediately any sick calf. Have it treated without delay.




