MANAGERIAL PROBE INTO COTTAGE REPAIR ALLEGATIONS

**I Have Been Victimised
Claims Co. Councillor**
Following allegations dealing with cottage repairs in his area made by Councillor E. Cahill (Kilmadon), at last Monday's meeting of Waterford County Council in Dungarvan it was agreed that an investigation should be carried out by the County Manager, Mr. J. A. O'Connor, into the complaints made.

The matter came up on a notice of motion dated January 23 in Mr. Cahill's name, to ask the manager for a report on the spending of £5,000 on cottage repairs since April 1965, with details of the number of cottages repaired, the names of the repairers, the cost of each cottage and who recommended the repair.

Mr. Cahill said that he had not a list giving the details he requested from the housing section and he had made certain inquiries from some of the tenants of the cottages listed. In one case where the repair costs were given as £27-14-11, he found that twenty and a half slates had been put on the roof of a cottage. In other cases he found that repairs had not been carried out at all and he produced a list of cottages where repairs had not been carried out in the past year or that they were started but were not finished. The total amount of the repairs in the list, up to the time of the meeting, was £2,507-19-8.

Mr. J. B. Hally, a sworn valuer, said that no one could be held responsible for the costs involved, but that Mr. Cahill's point without having any prior notice.

Mr. Cahill replied that he expected such a reply pointing out that his notice was on the agenda for 2 months prior to the meeting and this was a sworn inquiry into this whole affair.

Mr. Cahill said that he was completely unreasonable for a sworn inquiry would require a notice of motion. Mr. Cahill will get the inquiry he is entitled to. Mr. W. Foran, who is a member of the Council, said that he was not in favour of the investigation because of the costs involved. "We," he said, "have our own officials and they can investigate the repairs on cottages which were kept but would investigate the complaints made by Mr. Cahill."

NO DOORS, WINDOWS
Mr. Cahill wanted this sworn inquiry. He said that he was a man who had to live with his crippled wife and five children in a house with no doors or no windows and nothing was done to repair it. He said that he had been in the Co. Manager to hold an inquiry into these allegations. Mr. Cahill said that he had not got the inquiry he sought he would take the matter up with the Minister. He will write Mr. Boland myself.

THE FENIANS AT HELVICK
I have been returning during the past couple of weeks to the Fenians who have been mentioned in the "Leader" in connection with the Fenian Rising which occurred on March 5, 1867 and I suppose it is only right that I should write something about Waterford's association with the Fenians.
Nine years ago, in September 1858, the monument erected in memory of the Fenians who landed at Ballinbeg, Ring from the "Erin's Hope" was unveiled by Mrs. Tom Clarke, widow of the great Fenian and 1919 leader.
The 24 feet high monument which overlooks Helvick pier and Dungarvan Harbour stands on a 12 foot square base of rough stone topped by an obelisk of 32 stones—one for every Fenian who landed from the Brigantine.
The story of the voyage of the "Erin's Hope" across the Atlantic, full of danger and daring bravery as it was, reads like an adventure thriller. Captured by a Waterford man, Captain Kavanagh from Passage East, the little ship was harassed by severe storms and was several days behind schedule when she came within sight of the Irish coast. She then had to run the blockade of English Naval ships, but after landing the 32 Fenians (who were captured) she had to beat a hasty retreat out to sea and returned to America with the arms and ammunition which had been stowed in the hold. The elements being favourable, the time schedule observed could have other means so much to those brave rebel Fenians of '67.

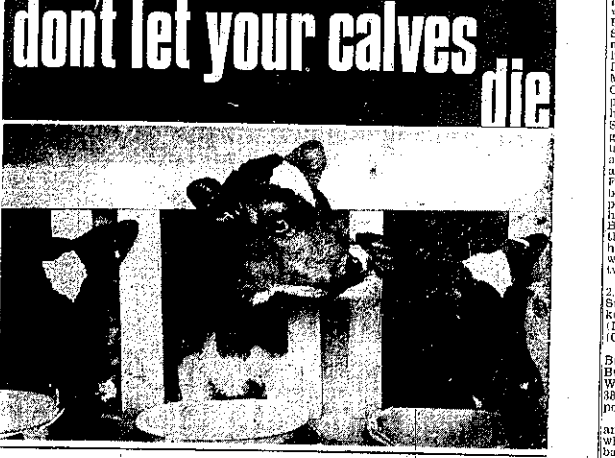
