ESSATION OF
EMPLOYMENT
ORDERS

announced in our advertisements
columns, the Minister for
Social Welfare has made an
arrangement with the
Employment Assistance
Commissioner, Period 1967,
to extend the period of
unemployment assistance
holders whose last payment
is in excess of £1 from
April 1st to October 31st, 1967.
As at the revocation, these
holders will now be able
to apply again for unemployment
assistance from April 1st to
April 1967 if they are unemployed
on that date. The same
formalities to enable
them to resume their benefit
will be followed by Local Officers
concerned.

Persons will no longer be a
feature of the Employment
Assistance Commission. Period
either this year or next year
would be in the normal
