Precautions against Foot and Mouth disease

Control on Movement of Animals

- (a) from Marts
- (b) on import from Six Counties and

The following restrictions now apply to the above-mentioned movements of cattle, sheep and pigs:-

(a) MOVEMENT FROM MARTS

Cattle, sheep and pigs may be moved out of a livestock mart (including Dublin Cattle Market) only under licence.
Lidences will be issued by officers of the Department of Agriculture and Fisheries at the marts and will be given only for

- (1) animals going direct to a meat factory, abattoir or slaughterhouse for slaughter, and
- (2) animals going direct to a port (including a Stx County port) for shipment or to a slaughterhouse in the Six Counties.

This means that no animal sent to a mart can subsequently be brought back to any farm. It must go direct for slaughter or for export.

(b) IMPORT FROM SIX COUNTIES

are required for the import of cattle. sheep and pigs from the Six Counties, Licences will be issued at the border posts and will be given only for

- (f) animals going direct to a meat factory, abattoir or slaughterhouse for slaughter, and
- (2) animals going direct to a port for export,

Cattle, sheep and pigs presented at parts for shipment must have come direct from a livestock mart or direct from the.

Six Countries and be accompanied by a licence, Animals presented at a barder post for shipment through a Six Country port or for export to a Six Country shaden and be accompanied by a licence, at should be noted that cattle for shipment must be accompanied by a special licence and that a Blue Card will not suffice.
