





Movement of people within the State

Restrictions on the movement of people coming from Britain have been relaxed. On and from Thursday, 11th April, there will be no restriction whatever on the movement of people arriving in the State who have not been in a Foot and Mouth Disease infected Area in Britain within twelve one days prior to their arrival.

The restrictions still apply to people coming from Britain who, charge the 21 days prior to arrival in this country, have been an Britain which at any time within that period was a Foot and Wooth Disease Infected Area and they may not visit am such places or premises in this country for 21 days after strial.

People who came from Britain within the 21 days prior to Thursday, 11th April, 1968, if they had been in or on any of the specified places or premises, in an infected Area in Britain during the 21 days prior to arrival in this country will be subject to the above-mentioned movement restrictions for 21 days from the date they arrived in this country.

The owner or any person holding a position of responsi-bility in any of the premises or places listed below is required to deny entry thereto to persons to whom the restrictions apply.

(a) Any wholesale meat market;
(b) any premises in which meat or meat products are processed too sale other than a retail premises or a catering establishment;
(c) any artificial insemination station;
(d) any creamery or any other premises used for the processing of milk;
(e) any cold size.
