This new Scheme is being operated by Committees of Agriculture on behalf of the Department of Agriculture and Fisheries. It aims at heloing small farmers to realise Under the Scheme, any eligible small farmer can earn a bonus grant of 2200 if he carries out, over a four year period, a farm development plan agreed with his Agricultural Adviser.

The development plan will be designed to raise the level of production of the farm so as to yield a Gross Margin of not less than £700 a year duction. The larm development plan will normally be set out in four stages, each capable of being achieved in 12 months. On satisfactory completion of each stage, the farmer will be paid 550.

Participants in the Scheme will be required to keep simple farm records,
