PENSMAN takes you Behind the Spotlight

FAMOUS CHICAGO BAND'S VISIT
The strident pipes and the shrill of horns is nothing new to Dungarvan especially during the past fifteen years since the local Pipe Band was first formed. But there will be a new air to the familiar sounds on next Saturday afternoon when the Shannon Rivers Pipe Band of Chicago visit the town and give a recital at the Square. This will be a big occasion for Dungarvan and an equally big one for the twenty-eight members of the Chicago band as a real big welcome for them is being planned in the Old Bar.

The band is due to return to Chicago on June 21. The names of the Band, which incidentally includes five girls, read like a list from a book of Irish genealogy: there are Reams, a Whelan, O'Hara and Garvey; there are Foyles, Loftuses, Harrisons, and a Lynch. Foyles and Taylor are native Chicagoans and there are Garvey, McHugh, Hudson, McKeown, Woods and McWilliams.

Incidentally the visitors will not all be coming as complete strangers to Dungarvan. There is at least one local resident who has spent many years in the band. He is Mr. Jim Cullinan, a native of County Wick and who is a close friend of Mr. Tommy Ryan, the band's conductor and of his family. The band members amongst his friends are Mr. Jim Cullinan, John, Road, Abneyville, and others who are members of the band. PLAYED FOR FOUR U.S. PRESIDENTS
One of the highlights of the early years was a 1928 performance for President-elect Al Smith, while on turning over to pipes. This was the only time that another party to a presidential candidate. This time it was Frank D. Roosevelt.

Through the years they have played for three other U.S. Presidents: Dwight D. Eisenhower, John F. Kennedy and Lyndon B. Johnson. In the 1920's and 1930's they played for the late President Sean T. O'Kelly and in 1953 they played for Mr. Sean Lemass, the then Taoiseach, when he visited Chicago.

Long a favourite of Mayor Daley, the band represents his own 11th Ward and the Cook County Central Committee of the American Democratic Party in parades and fairs. In 1954 Mayor Daley brought the band to Boston for a performance with him to Atlantic City for the Democratic National Convention.

Walsh (F.G.) calling for the building of a new 100-bed hospital in Dungarvan. Mr. O'Connor, the Health Authority's medical officer, said that the Health Authority had set up a select committee to examine the whole matter of hospital provision in the county and had set the end of May as the deadline for their report.
